God used a variety of experiences in Jerry's past to prepare him for his work at RPTS as President and Professor of Pastoral Theology. Prior to his pastoral ministry, his experiences included teaching at a Christian middle school and a public inner city high school, coaching high school and college basketball teams, serving in the infantry of the 101st Airborne Division in Vietnam, and serving as Dean of Student Development at a Christian college for five years.

He served for nearly fourteen years as the first pastor of the Reformed Presbyterian Church of Columbus, IN, before coming to the Reformed Presbyterian Theological Seminary in 1995.

During his tenure at RPTS, Jerry has been respected widely not only for his teaching but also for his mentoring, having an open-door policy for current students and for anyone who walks in off the street to learn more about the Seminary. Known as "Dr. Jerry" to some, he has been a friend to all these past twenty-three years. He is never too busy to pray with or talk to students, faculty, or staff.

Jerry's wife, Ann, has been by his side all these years, mentoring the wives of students preparing for pastoral ministry and encouraging other women serving in the church. Her presence will also be missed.

After his retirement on June 30, 2018, Jerry will continue to encourage folks near and far to support the work of RPTS and to consider becoming students. And he just might find time to eat more ice cream along the way!
